### Career Development and Transferable Skills Training

The AHRC Career Development and Transferable Skills Training Fund (previously the Research Training Fund) is calculated on the basis of £850 per doctoral award holder and this payment will be transferred to your institution. Although this fund is linked to individual student numbers, it is not intended to be spent on the training needs of individual students i.e. the funding should not be allocated to an individual. The Fund is intended to support generic training primarily for the benefit of Research Council funded researchers, though the funds should be used in a way that will have as broad an impact as possible on other researchers. Award holders are encouraged to make full use of the training provided by the institution where they are studying.

\*\* You are only entitled to the total amount if your course or programme of study is for the full academic year (i.e. 1 October 2010 - 30 September 2011) and you are registered for the entire time. If your course or programme of study finishes earlier than 30th September, then the payment will be pro-rated to reflect the actual duration.

\*\*\* The figures shown for fees and maintenance are the annual entitlement figure, due if you are registered for the entire time. The fees and maintenance will be paid quarterly in equal installments on 1 October, 1 January, 1 April and 1 July.
